Till today, UCatapult has conducted over 1000+ online sessions with the support of its 65+ teachers who have all come together, to make learning accessible to the underprivileged and disadvantaged. Each individual of UCatapult is on a mission, driven by focused passion to create an able future for tomorrow. How else will you explain, the support and contribution of numerous individuals on this mission who are everyday voluntarily investing their time, energy, and funds to teach these disadvantaged students, and giving them tools to dream big and fly high.

OUR INITIATIVES

CHESHTA

Cheshta — is a UCatapult endeavor to reach rural, govt. schools' teachers to help them upskill and make them more self-reliant in a sustained fashion. It is a project brainchild born out of the hope to fill in the inequalities and the gaping gaps in education by empowering the teaching facilitators to create the best possible output. At Cheshta, we equip the teachers through a battery of training programmes, directed at perfecting themselves to deliver their classes, at four strategic levels- the Formative, the Primary, the Middle and Secondary levels, that form the crux of every stage of the academic years. During this lockdown period, UCatapult has successfully conducted over 150+ trainings for over 1700+ teachers/facilitators various academic across subjects primarily in the state of Bihar & rural UP. We currently have over 20+ resource people working this initiative pro-bono. It is our 'Cheshta' to enable our teachers with the best skills -from across the world.



BUNIYAAD


UCatapult worked with identified change leaders from chosen few schools in rural Bihar & UP, and started the Alternative Virtual School -an online initiative - to teach students of class VI to X and help them to learn to read as per NEP 2020. The teaching is done over a mobile handset -provided both in individual as well as group setting.

A key differentiator of UCatapult is that it has strong knowledge resource, made of both urban and rural teachers. Urban teachers help with designing learning modules, and rural teachers help in facilitating the course content in these segments. Our local teachers from remote Bihar play an integral role in delivering our course content. They help us with mobilizing support within communities for our learning initiative, share their learning needs and requirements, and help us deliver better.

Our Interactive and engaging digital curriculum, is delivered by qualified & certified teachers from India & abroad, in simple Hindi language to build the students' solid foundation and start them on the path to being a lifelong learner.


We Focus on storytelling classes to immerse students in English language and encourage development of students' affinity with English. An observable change could be seen in students' confidence, command and interaction with English. Their vocabulary, syntax and pragmatic knowledge showed a huge leap. The subjects which were dealt with in the subject classes were- English grammar, Science, Heritage Education and Mathematics.

Additionally, we also ran Saturday special classes like — Astronomy, Robotics, Performing Arts — Theatre, Indian music, Heritage Education etc. These classes are taken by subject experts and also by some students as teacher. We also conduct workshops for Parents & Students on topics like cyber security, general counselling, gender sensitivity and more. Setting up the Buniyaad to build a better future.



KATHAKAAR

Education must be an experience, not a forced one. The joy of learning must be the underlying ethos. Education should be the means of connecting people with their own community, culture and heritage. Kathakaar is a storyteller, who shares his/her journey of growth and assimilation, and in the process inspires these young students. The idea is about 'giving back to your roots' and helping young learners in the process - connect with their own community and take pride in their culture. So far, students from Sitamarhi and Motihari have gathered copious information amounts of the history. culture on demographics of Bihar and their districts. They have also been benefitted by learning from the journey of achievers from Bihar, who are settled across the globe and are immensely proud of their roots. The project has two broad stages. In the first stage, children are trained to explore and present the stories about their region/state. In the second stage, these trained ambassadors share their research, vision, perspective, along with their story - with the masses (via institutions).



SAKSHAM

It is said that if we teach/empower a man, we only educate one learner, but if we empower one woman – we educate a full village. Saksham is a program where we ask rural, less/under privileged women to join us to rise, shine and contribute to society in their own small way.

The objective of Saksham is to provide self-sufficiency to community women – so that they upskill and earn their livelihood better and enhance their standard of living. UCatapult provides Career Counselling, Short online skill development courses (Beautician, Embroidery, Fine Arts etc.) and Counselling sessions for parents etc.

In addition to above, for women who had to leave their education mid-way -because of either financial or personal reasons – and they want to re-start the same (irrespective of their age), UCatapult enables their further education (or completion of education) via enrolment through NIOS, and paying all admission expenses, enabling their teaching via competent outside teachers and takes care of all their academic expenditure.



PUSTAKALAY

"A room without books is like a body without soul". Our Pustakalya initiative is built on the the foundation of child's access to books. Our mission to set up atleast five physical libraries in such Bihar's out back will serve both as an educational resource and satisfy their curious minds.

It is our "koshish" towards Reforming the community with access to un-interrupted learning. "If Knowledge and Learning decide to journey to the ends of the earth, who are we mortals to stop them? In the new-normal situation, when half the world is still continuing with learning and teaching through computer, laptop and smart phone, there is this other half which is struggling to keep pace, in our own country. So, our endeavors at Ucatapult will ensure that every child gets his/her window to the world of books, where they feel welcomed and motivated to learn and grow.

Our vision to construct a physical library will continue to feature more creative and advanced attributes in future such as mobile library to establish a well set-up knowledge hub for these kids.



VIDYA VAANI

Vidyavaani - COMMUNITY RADIO

Vidyavaani is a community radio initiative dedicated to promoting education from Pre-Primary to Functional Literacy through broadcasts in regional languages. In collaboration with Bharat FM, it offers internet radio programming three times a week, delivering educational content that caters to diverse literacy levels.

Vidyavani initiative celebrates International Mother Language Day with storytelling sessions in six languages, extending over 100 days. Each week features one story and two activities, reaching community schools in Bihar, Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, and Punjab, for pre-primary and primary students. With contributions from prominent RJs, the program supports language acquisition, boosts self-esteem, and enhances parent-child interaction. Backed by the Ministry of Education and state boards, it underscores the benefits of mother tongue education.

This initiative not only provides essential learning resources but also fosters community engagement, ensuring that educational opportunities reach underserved populations, helping bridge the educational gap in rural and remote areas.
